Discussion:

- Approval of Sessional Dates – 2014/2015
SCAP approved the 2014/2015 sessional dates for the Faculty of Arts and Science, School of Nursing, School of Business (all programs), School of Medicine, Faculty of Engineering and Applied Science, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Education, and the School of Graduate Studies.

Faculty of Law sessional dates have changed to include a Fall term recess from November 3 to November 7, and extended the 2014/2015 examination periods.
- Sessional Dates (13 week term) and Remembrance Day Closure referrals made by Senate
Dan Bradshaw, Associate Vice-Principal – Faculty Relations, was invited to speak to the motion referrals in light of the Queen's QUFA Collective Agreement and the Queen's-PSAC Local 901 Unit 1 Collective Agreement. A report and recommendation to Senate is anticipated in the spring of 2014.
- Discussions regarding the status of official observers to SCAP have continued. It is anticipated that this will be finalized in January.
- To provide clarity to impacted students, faculty and staff, the Exams subcommittee has interpolated the Policy on Disrupted Examinations in the event that adverse weather conditions cause exam cancellation.
